# Truck art competition

## The art competition

Students are encouraged to create an A4 - A3 landscape artwork that celebrates the theme 'Let's send less to landfill' using the template provided at [www.kesab.asn.au/schools/port-pirie-art-competition/](http://www.kesab.asn.au/schools/port-pirie-art-competition/)

Artwork can be in paper or digital format and entries may be submitted individually, or as a class or school effort. Kindergarten to year 12 students who attend a school in the Port Pirie Regional Council can enter, with entries judged in three age categories. One entry will be selected from each category for each truck and an open age category for the street sweeper.

The artwork should show the importance of recycling properly as well as the environmental benefits of recycling. Students are prompted to consider what goes in the recycling 'yellow lid' bin and how simple it can be to remember to always recycle correctly.

Winning artwork will be displayed on the side of a local Council collection vehicle with the school / site logo and the vehicle will visit the school / site.

## Conditions of entry

- 1) All children who attend a school or preschool in the Port Pirie Regional Council area are eligible to enter.
- 2) Competition commences 2/08/2021 and closes 27/08/2021.
- 3) To enter; create an artwork that depicts the theme of "Let's send less to landfill".
- 4) Entries must be submitted using the template provided at [www.kesab.asn.au/schools/port-pirie-art-competition/](http://www.kesab.asn.au/schools/port-pirie-art-competition/). Entries must be flat (no sculpture or collage), landscape orientation in either A4 or A3 size (A3 preferred) without creases, or as a digital pdf file.
- 5) Complete the entry form on this document and attach to the back of the artwork or with the digital file. Return these to your child's teacher, who will submit these to Wendy Sutton, KESAB *environmental solutions*, 214 Grange Road, Flinders Park 5025. [wendy@kesab.asn.au](mailto:wendy@kesab.asn.au)
- 6) Entries may be submitted individually, or as a class or school effort. Only one entry per individual, class or school effort will be accepted.
- 7) Each entry will be individually judged by KESAB *environmental solutions* and Port Pirie Regional Council employees. Entries will be judged based on artistic merit and how well they depict the competition theme. There are three age categories including Early Years (Preschool to Yr 2), Primary (Year 3-7) and Secondary (Years 8-12). An open age category will apply to the street sweeper artwork. There is opportunity for 4 winners in total.
- 8) The judges' decision is final, no correspondence will be entered into.
- 9) Parents/ guardians and schools of the winner and finalists will be notified by 13/09/2021.
- 10) The winner will have their artwork and school logo printed on a truck or street sweeper. The truck / sweeper will visit the associated school.
- 11) All entries will remain the property of KESAB *environmental solutions* and Port Pirie Regional Council.
- 12) Entrants' names, their photographs and work may be used by KESAB *environmental solutions* and/or Port Pirie Regional Council for promotional purposes.
- 13) KESAB *environmental solutions* and Port Pirie Regional Council reserve the right to slightly alter the winning artwork for promotional use.
- 14) KESAB *environmental solutions* and Port Pirie Regional Council will not be held liable for loss or damage to the entries.
- 15) Entries received may not be returned.
- 16) KESAB *environmental solutions* and Port Pirie Regional Council reserve the right to cancel the competition if no suitable entries are received.
