Are you looking for fun and exciting education programs that can enhance your students understanding of waste and recycling processes? KESAB offer excursions, incursions and in-school support.



INCURSION OPTIONS

RECYCLE RELAY 45 MINS • SUITABLE FOR KINDERGARTEN - YR 12

This activity will get the students brains and legs moving! Students work in relay teams to sort real materials into 'landfill', 'recycling' and 'organics' bins. After the race, the contents of the bins are examined, and 'tricky' items discussed with the group. The activity and the bin colours replicate your local council bin system, enabling students to become great recyclers at home too!



PAPERMAKING WORKSHOP 1 HR • SUITABLE FOR KINDERGARTEN - YR 12

Students of all ages can make their own recycled paper in just one session! KESAB can provide you with the equipment and expertise to assist your students in producing their own recycled paper, as well as understanding the links to recycling and environmental sustainability. A demonstration of the process is given to the whole group, before splitting into smaller groups, where each student will get to create their own piece of recycled paper.

BEESWAX WRAP WORKSHOP 1.5 HRS • SUITABLE FOR KINDERGARTEN - YR 12

Beeswax wrap workshops are an opportunity for students (and staff) to make their own personalised plasticfree alternative to cling wrap – a fantastic way to reduce waste and create something beautiful, practical and eco-friendly! Workshops can be modified to suit all year levels and all participants get their own personalised wrap to take home and use, plus care instructions and a DIY manual so they can do it again themselves!



JOURNEY OF MY FOOD WORKSHOP 1 HR • SUITABLE FOR YR 4 - 7

The 'Journey of my Food' is an interactive workshop which follows the journey of common food items, encouraging students to think critically about the resources which went into making that food and the consequences of waste. During the session we will cover a range of concepts such as embodied water, food miles, different packaging materials, cosmetic standards and household food waste.



LITTER LESS 1.5 HRS • SUITABLE FOR YR 4 - 7

The Litter Less incursion will focus on awareness, understanding and actioning of litter issues at school, in the community and the environment. Following an introduction and discussion about litter, what it is and how it spreads students will participate in a sample litter audit in the school grounds. Students will look at the results of the sample litter audit to identify the types of litter found, litter hotspots and consider bin placement. Students can then develop an action plan for the school, to reduce litter.





EXCURSION OPTIONS

KESAB EDUCATION CENTRE

The KESAB Education Centre is located at Integrated Waste Services, (IWS) Wingfield. The centre is a purpose built education facility on a working site where visitors can have a sensory experience of what happens to their waste and recycling materials once their bins leave the kerbside. Drawing together elements of the natural environment, indigenous environmental stewardship and modern waste management and resource recovery, the education centre provides the base for interactive education sessions.

SCHOOL SUPPORT OPTIONS

BIN SYSTEM ASSESSMENT

1 - 2 HRS • WITH KEY STAFF MEMBERS

A Bin System Assessment (BSA) is a great way to receive advice, recommendations, and new ideas for improving waste management systems at your site. KESAB staff can conduct a BSA walkthrough of your site (accompanied by key staff) to suggest improvements to existing systems to help improve resource recovery and reduce waste to landfill. Preschool assessments are about **1 hour**, while Primary or High School assessments take **1.5-2 hours**. A report will be provided to your site.



COMPOST OR WORM FARM WORKSHOP

1 HR • SUITABLE FOR KINDERGARTEN - YR 12

Have you considered establishing your own compost system or worm farm at school? Compost and garden expert Alan Shepard can visit your school to work with you and your students to set up a compost or worm farm system. The sessions also include how to maintain a healthy compost or worm farm system and the importance of diverting food from landfill. (Note - if you do not have your own compost bin/worm farm at the time of the session, one will be brought to be used for the demonstration. But we do recommend you purchase a system beforehand).
