

## COVID risk statement

At KESAB we take the risk of COVID-19 and the health of our staff and school staff and students seriously.

KESAB and staff continually monitor and follow the latest updates and recommendations given by SA Health and the Department for Education South Australia. Protocols and procedures are in place at the KESAB office to minimise the spread of Covid-19.



A KESAB Education Officer will:

- Not attend a school or Education Centre if feeling unwell, or if anyone in their household is unwell or been diagnosed with COVID-19.
- Not attend a school or Education Centre if they have travelled interstate or overseas to a known COVID-19 hotspot.
- Not attend a school or Education Centre if they have undertaken a COVID-19 test and are awaiting results regardless of whether they feel well.

When at your school, a KESAB Education Officer will:

- Follow policies and procedures for educators as recommended by the school (including filling out all necessary paperwork on arrival).
- Follow recommended personal hygiene and social distancing protocols.
- Sanitise equipment between schools and between sessions (where possible).
- Ensure any equipment that is brought in and used by students has been sanitised.

When classes attend a KESAB Education Centre, a KESAB Education Officer will:

- Follow recommended personal hygiene and social distancing protocols
- Sanitise equipment between school attendances and between sessions (where possible)

It is expected that school will follow the recommended COVID Safe procedures. If the school is aware of a student or employee at the school who is diagnosed with COVID-19, KESAB must be informed immediately.
