

## COVID-19 risk statement

At KESAB we take the risk of COVID-19 and the health of our staff and the community seriously.

KESAB and staff continually monitor and follow the latest Covid-19 updates and recommendations given by SA Health and the Department for Education South Australia. Protocols and procedures are in place at the KESAB office to minimise the spread of Covid-19.

A KESAB Education Officer will:

- Follow all applicable SA Health requirements with respect to COVID-19.
- Not attend or facilitate a community session if feeling unwell, or if anyone in their household has been diagnosed with COVID-19.
- Not attend or facilitate a community session if they have undertaken a COVID-19 test and are awaiting results regardless of whether they feel well.

When delivering an education session, a KESAB Education Officer will:

- Follow all relevant legal requirements, policies and procedures as recommended by SA Health and the site (including filling out all necessary paperwork on arrival).
- Follow recommended personal hygiene and social distancing protocols.
- Sanitise equipment between schools and between sessions (where possible).
- Ensure any equipment that is brought in and used by students has been sanitised.

When community attends a KESAB Education Centre, a KESAB Education Officer will:

- Follow recommended personal hygiene and social distancing protocols
- Sanitise equipment between visitors and between sessions (where possible)

It is expected that members of the community will follow the recommended COVID Safe procedures.
