BUSINESS TOURS

The waste & recycling industry in South Australia contributes \$4.78 million to the local economy and employs over 3,000 people. In SA we generate over 5 million tonnes of waste material (2020-21):

- Over 4.2 million tonnes (83.3%) is recovered as a resource, of which:
- 89% is processed here in SA
- Saving over 1.1 million tonnes of GHGe emissions

The old linear economic model is fast giving way to a more circular approach - shifting waste avoidance, reuse and remanufacturing into the spotlight. A KESAB education officer will lead an informative behind-the-scenes tour of some of SA's recycling and waste facilities, to see first-hand the reality of resource recovery in SA.

You will be provided with information to make educated decisions about businesses waste, products and purchasing, and your team will be empowered to make positive change.

WHICH BIN: WASTE AND RECYCLING INFORMATION SESSION

Approx. 45 minutes.

Wondering which bin is best and what happens next?

A KESAB education officer can come to you to shed some light on the subject with an engaging and informative presentation. Learn about the what, how and why of waste and recycling so that you have context to remember and empower positive choices.

BIN MATERIALS AUDIT

For a comprehensive analysis and quantification of your waste, a Bin Materials Audit (BMA) is ideal. Trained KESAB audit staff can sort 24 hours worth of waste material generated by your site, according to Green Industries SA guidelines and your specific requirements.
