Recycle Rhythms

This activity walks children through the journey of the kerbside bins via visual Big Books and an interactive bin game.

Using rhymes to help them remember, children place materials into coloured bins, tailored to your site.

For best results, we recommend working with a half class at a time.

Approx 30 mins x 2 (half class)
or 45 mins (whole class)

Composting and/or Worm Farms

Wipe Out Waste

Wipe Out Waste is KESAB's schools program aimed at minimising waste, promoting circular economy and maximising sustainability. Wipe Out Waste is free for South Australian schools and is supported through a partnership with Green Industries SA.

Staff professional development (PD)

Professional development sessions will provide staff with an enhanced understanding of resource management in SA, site-specific and 'tricky waste' information, and information about the WOW school program. With sufficient demand, there are opportunities for in-person tours of resource recovery and recycling sites.

Bin Systems / Usage Assessment

A guided walk-through of your site providing opportunities to identify contamination issues and potential improvements, explore ways to improve material separation, reduce materials to landfill, improve and encourage student ownership for waste management.

Bin Materials Audit

A Bin Materials Audit will provide an engaging out-of-classroom learning experience and establish baseline data for your site to measure future success against. WOW staff will work with students in small groups during the day to audit a days' worth of bin materials from the site. An audit report is provided with results and recommendations for actions to improve resource management at your school.

WOW Show

An interactive, STEM-focused introduction to recycling systems, reducing food packaging in schools and preschools, and use of your school's bin system. The audience for the WOW Show is Reception - Year 6 students, staff and parents.
