RECYCLING RHYTHMS

APPROX. 30 MINS

This activity walks children through the journey of the kerbside bins via visual big books and an interactive bin game. Children place materials into coloured bins tailored to your local council bin system, with rhymes to remember. A discussion about tricky items can help answer any questions and support good resource management onsite and at home.

PAPERMAKING

APPROX. 60 MINS

KESAB provides the materials, equipment and expertise to assist children to make their own recycled paper, with links to recycling and environmental sustainability. A demonstration of the process is given to the whole group, before splitting into smaller groups where each child will get to create their own piece of recycled paper.



*Minimum of four adult assistants required depending on the size of the group. A wet area is recommended, ideally with hard floors for easy cleaning. A DIY papermaking kit is available for hire from the KESAB website.

COMPOSTING OR WORM FARMS

APPROX. 60 MINS

Our compost and garden expert can visit your site to demonstrate how to establish and maintain a healthy compost or worm farm. A great session for school gardens, this workshop can also be run as an indoor presentation.



*These sessions are beneficial if your site has existing compost or worm farm systems, or intends to acquire one for the session. Our expert can advise on best options for your site.
