Recycle Relay

Embrace healthy competition to explore resource management with this highly active exploration of local bin systems.

Great for kinesthetic learners.

Space is required to run the relay and session may be adjusted to suit ages.

Metals & the Circular Economy

Explore physical and chemical properties of common metals and alloys, their uses and value, and the resources saved through a circular economy model approach. This engaging hands-on session would make an excellent introduction to a Design and Technologies unit or a Physical / Chemical Sciences unit.

This session requires access to a large screen and electricity.

Paper-making

A practical, hands-on introduction to resource recovery, material science and environmentally conscious choices. This session can be tailored to Year 10-12 Business and Enterprise students. A wet area is recommended for this activity.

Journey of My Food

Through the lens of critical and environmentally conscious thinking, this interactive workshop explores issues of embodied water, food miles, aesthetic standards and waste management behind everyday choices.

Plastic-free lunches (Beeswax wraps)

Encourage environmentally and economically conscious thinking while supporting 'nude food' goals. In this sensory and creative workshop students design, make and take home a re-usable, plastic-free food wrap.

Teachers involvement required. An enclosed, ventilated hard floor space is required for safety, with easy access to 2+ powerpoints.

Litter Less

Help students become thoughtful environmental stewards as they explore local litter impacts and down-stream effects. This site-specific litter audit helps students plan tangible solutions.

This session requires a classroom space and outdoor areas for litter collection.

Approx 90 mins, Years 7-8

Maximum 2 sessions per day

Composting and/or Worm Farms

Our compost and garden gurus can visit your site to demonstrate how to establish and maintain a healthy compost or worm farm. A great session for school gardens, this workshop can also be run as an indoor presentation.

Our educators can advise on compost or worm farm systems best suited to your site.

Excursions

These excursions provide a sensory, real-world experience of resource management at a working facility. Students will participate in engaging educational activities and visit local recyclers / processors.

A bus is required for transport and session tour – cost & session times are exclusive of bus hire.

Adult ratio of 1:6 required, maximum 30 students.

Wipe Out Waste

Wipe Out Waste is KESAB's schools program aimed at minimising waste, promoting circular economy and maximising sustainability. Wipe Out Waste is free for South Australian schools and is supported through a partnership with Green Industries SA.

Staff professional development (PD)

Professional development sessions will provide staff with an enhanced understanding of resource management in SA, site-specific and 'tricky waste' information, and information about the WOW school program. With sufficient demand, there are opportunities for in-person tours of resource recovery and recycling sites.

Bin Systems / Usage Assessment

A guided walk-through of your site providing opportunities to identify contamination issues and potential improvements, explore ways to improve material separation, reduce materials to landfill, improve and encourage student ownership for waste management.

Bin Materials Audit

A Bin Materials Audit will provide an engaging out-of-classroom learning experience and establish baseline data for your site to measure future success against. WOW staff will work with students in small groups during the day to audit a days' worth of bin materials from the site. An audit report is provided with results and recommendations for actions to improve resource management at your school.
