# INCURSIONS

## RECYCLE RELAY

APPROX. 45 MINS • YR. 7-10

Embrace healthy competition to explore resource management and encourage sustainable choices with this highly active exploration of local bin systems. Great for kinesthetic learners.

*\*Space is required to run the relay & session may be adjusted to suit ages.*

## PAPERMAKING

APPROX. 40-60 MINS • YR. 7-10

A practical, hands-on introduction to resource recovery, material science and environmentally conscious choices.

*\*A wet area is recommended for this activity.*

## BEESWAX WRAP

APPROX. 60-90 MINS • YR. 7-12

Encourage environmentally and economically conscious thinking while supporting students to achieve 'nude food' goals. In this sensory and creative workshop students design, make and take home a re-usable, plastic-free food wrap.

*\*Session may be adjusted to suit the group and teachers must be involved. An enclosed, ventilated hard floor space is required for safety, with easy access to 2+ powerpoints.*

## JOURNEY OF MY FOOD

APPROX. 60 MINS • YR. 7-9

Improve critical and environmentally conscious thinking as students explore factors behind everyday choices. This interactive workshop explores embodied water, food miles, aesthetic standards, consumer choices and waste management.

## LITTER LESS

APPROX. 60-90 MINS • YR. 7-9

Help students become thoughtful environmental stewards as they explore impacts on the immediate environment and the down stream effects. This site-specific litter audit helps students assess local resource management and plan tangible solutions

*\*This session requires a classroom space and outdoor areas for litter collection. Max: 2/day*

## COMPOSTING OR WORM FARMS

APPROX. 60 MINS • YR. 7-12

Our compost and garden expert can visit your site to demonstrate how to establish and maintain a healthy compost or worm farm. A great session for school gardens, this workshop can also be run as an indoor presentation.
